

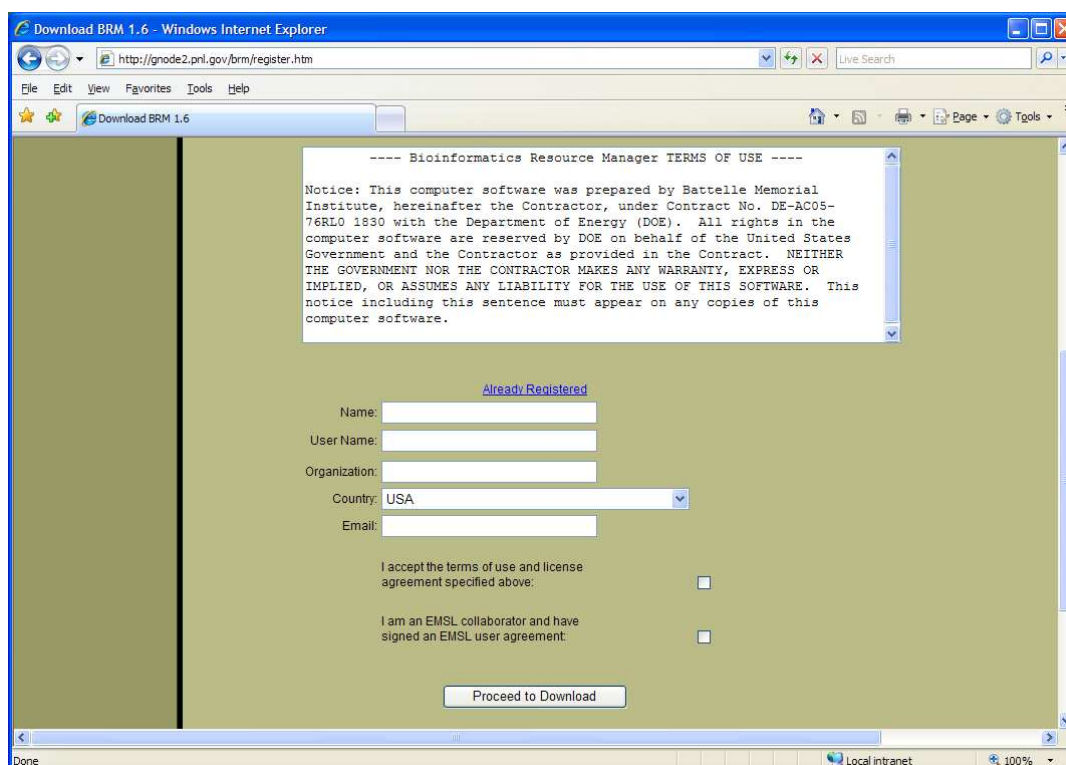
BRM (External Version) Quick Start Guide

1) Downloading and Installing:

Users must first register. This is accomplished by visiting the following webpage:

Upon visiting the web link, you should see the following:

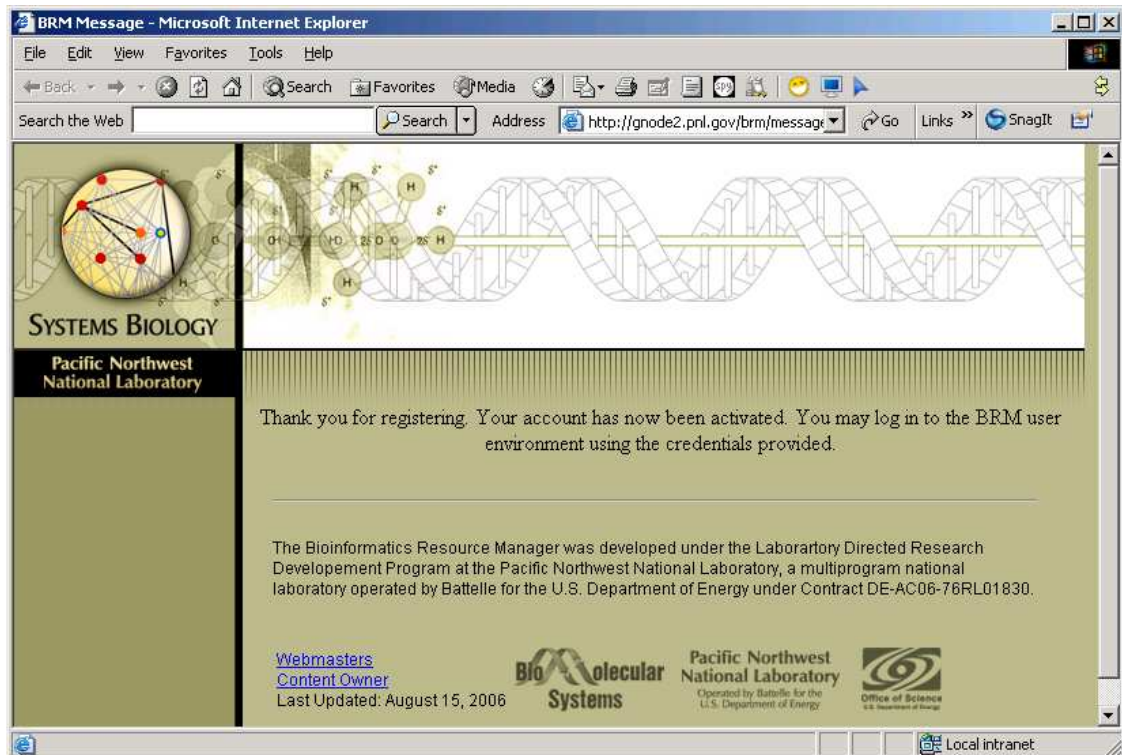
I am an EMSL collaborator and have signed an EMSL user agreement:

Read the TERMS OF USE and LICENSE AGREEMENT carefully. Then, fill in the information. For name, provide your first and last name. For username, provide a name that will identify you when you log in to the software. Your username should not contain spaces and should be easy for you to remember. Provide the name of your organization and email address. The email address **MUST BE A VALID EMAIL ADDRESS**. We cannot deliver your password to log in to the software without a valid email address. You **MUST ACCEPT** the terms of use and license agreement before downloading. If you are an EMSL collaborator and have signed an EMSL user agreement, please check the box so that we may identify you in our system. Otherwise, leave this unchecked. NOTE: If you check this box, we must verify that you are a collaborator. Checking this box will not provide you with any special privileges unless we have verified your identity.

Once you have provided all the required information and accepted the terms of use, you will be directed to a webpage to download the software.

You will also see an email in your inbox containing your user name and assigned password. In order to activate your account, you MUST follow the web link in the body of the message.

Upon clicking the link, you should be directed to the following page:



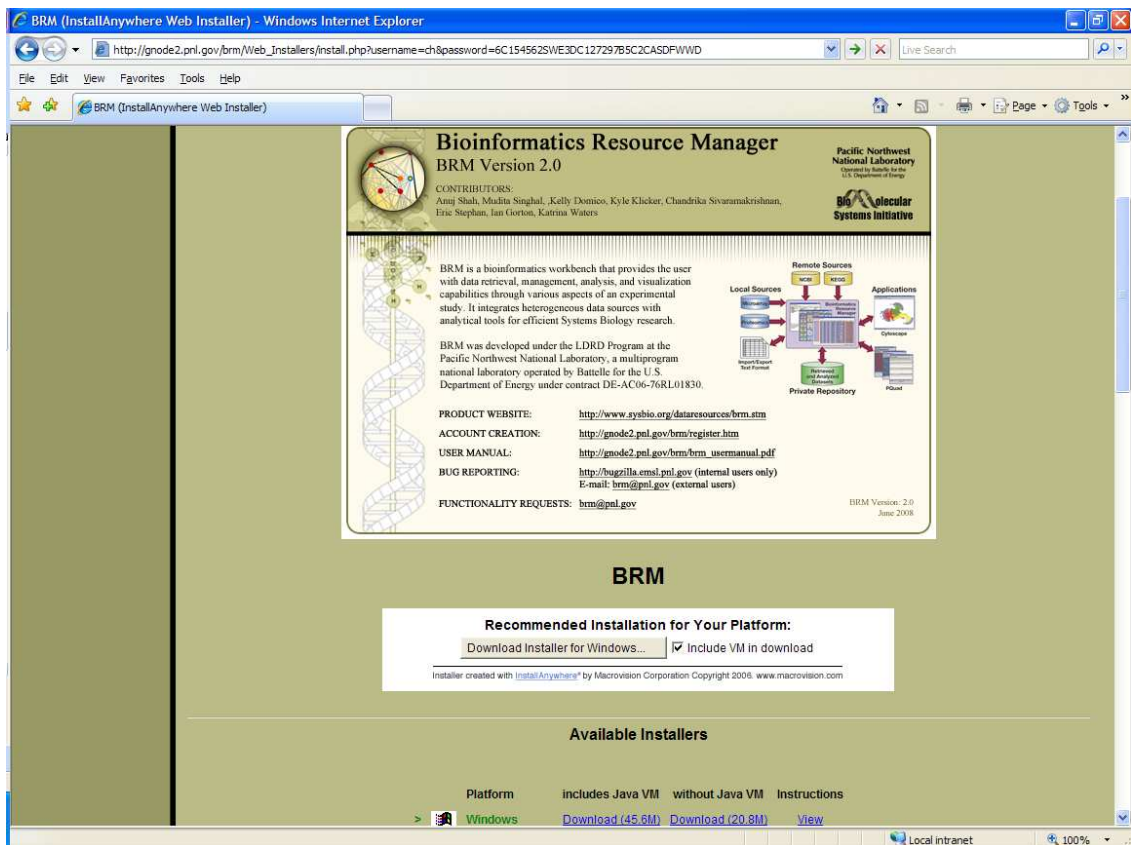
This page confirms that your account has been created and is now active. You may now log in to BRM using the account name and password provided in the email.

NOTE: The password assigned is for initial use. We strongly encourage changing this password to something more personal. To change the password, visit the following link:

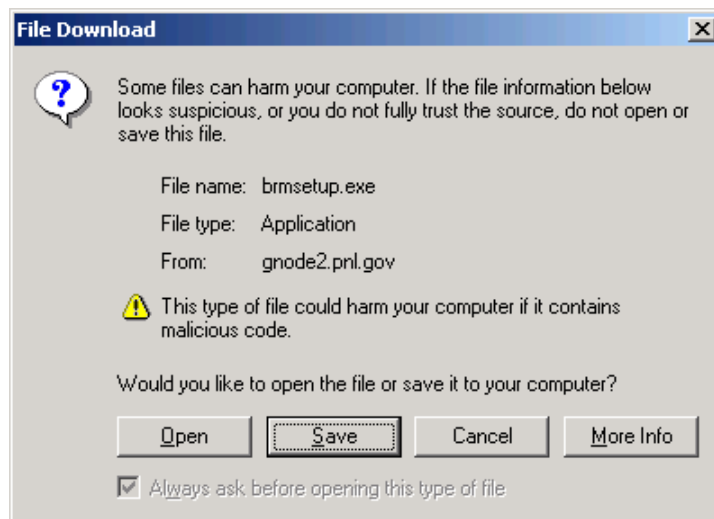

Go to the “Want to Change Your Password?” section. This link may also be used in order to recover your username, password, or both.

The download webpage looks at your environment and provides a button for the installer that best suits your environment. We recommend clicking on the button under “Recommended installation for your Platform”.



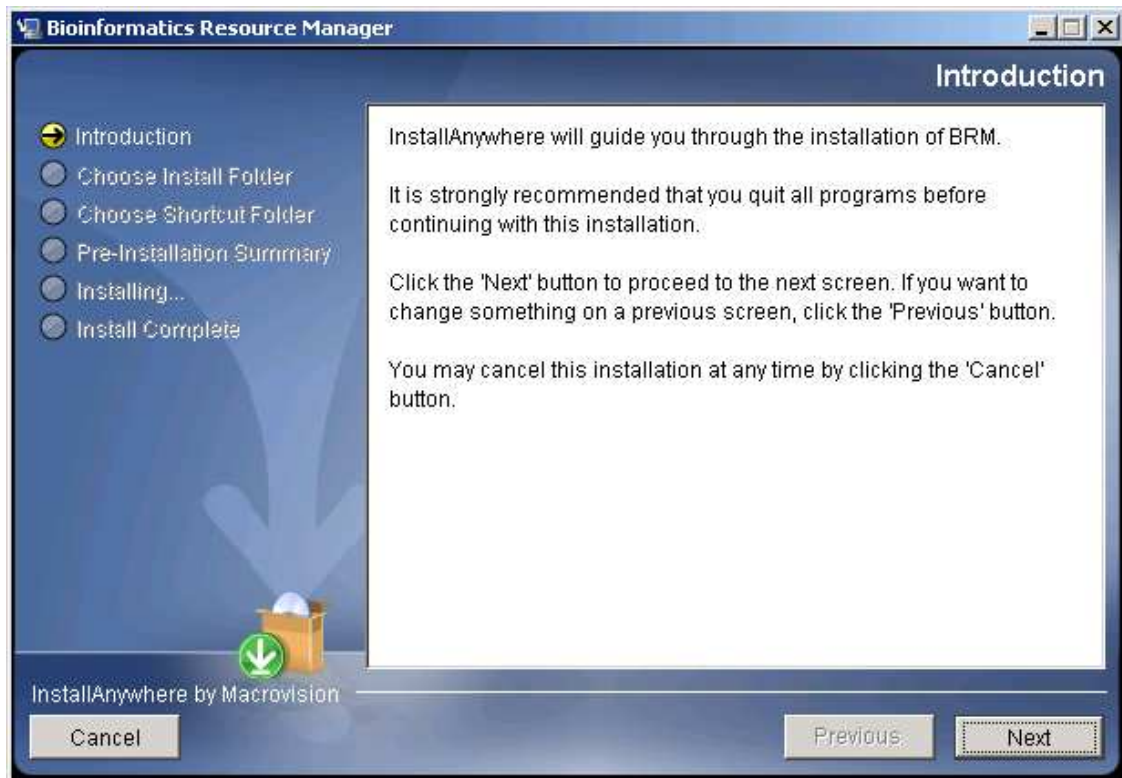
After clicking on the button mentioned, you will see a prompt similar in content to the one below:



Choose the “Open” option.

NOTE: This is NOT suspicious or harmful software, so please ignore the warning.

After choosing “Open”, the installer will be downloaded to a temporary folder and the installer will begin the install process. You should see the following:



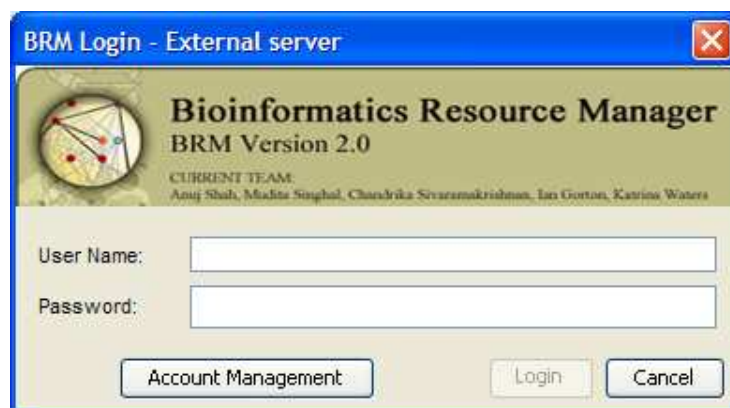
Continue the install process by clicking on the “Next” button. You will see a series of screens. Choose the defaults on each and click “Next”. When you see the “Pre-Installation Summary” screen, click the “Install” button. Make a note of the file system folders where the executable will be installed for future reference.

The installer will begin installing and you will see the following screen with a progress bar:



Once the process is finished, select the “Done” button. Congratulations! You have successfully installed BRM.

To launch the program, click the “BRM” icon on the desktop or go to the Start button and select the executable from the “Program Files” menu. You should see the following:



Now you may log in to the software using the BRM account you set up when registering.

NOTE ON PASSWORDS: Your passwords are encrypted in the database for your protection. Neither we nor anyone else can see your password. For this reason, if you

forget your password, we reassign a new password which we strongly encourage you to change to something more personal.
